




Individual Patient ages and genders

Incidents occurring in 15 UP counties, <u>all</u> patients in MI-EMSIS with "snowmobile" in the narrative and upon reading was a snowmobile crash

EXCLUDED

Organized snowmobile races, canceled calls, no crash found

Selection for analysis:

- > 15 UP Counties for incident occurrence
- December 1, 2022 –
 March 31, 2023
- 'snowmobile" in narrative

> Read narratives to ensure snowmobile crash

Regional Projects and Benchmarks

Snowmobile Project

- ♦ Spreadsheets December 1 March 31
- ♦ Addition of date/time arrive ED
- Audit for equal or more on spreadsheet than Registry
- ♦ Ensure Registry includes transfers
- ♦ EMS requested to use **snowmobile** in their narratives

ORV Project

♦ EMS requested to use side by side or SXS in their narratives

Transfer timeliness

- ♦ 120 minutes Level 1 TTA
- Audit filter, compile reasons and be ready to report

Collaboration of medical directors

- Trauma program and MCA meeting minutes
- ♦ New protocols

Trauma Triage! Does it align with Trauma Team Activation Criteria?

Training for EMS and hospital providers

Informing the employees, broad medical community, and community of trauma center once a year in addition to how to contact program

ICD-10 codes do not specify these types of ORVs!

The Region 8 Trauma Network wants to track and trend ORV crashes, just like we do with snowmobiles. Both of these other land transport types of crashes with critically injured patients rival the number of severely injured in motor vehicle crashes.

In your EMS patient care report narratives, please use:

side by side or SXS

This will allow us to keyword search your narratives. The Regional Trauma Coordinator will provide aggregate analysis to the Region 8 Trauma Network and the State of Michigan Ride Right Committee.



Regional Workplan

Workplan Changes

- ♦ The RTN met and approved the work of the RTAC.
- The Department modified some language with the most impactful being the Regional Preparedness staff needs to be non-voting or adjust and become members as EMS / nurses. The rules specify who can be on the RTAC.
- The Department brought the plan to the STAC. Approved.
- ♦ The Department creates edits and shares back to the Region.
- The RTC gathers the RTN signatures.
- ♦ The EMSCC approves.

Workplan objectives – next on slate

RTN is active within the region in the monitoring and evaluation of regional injury prevention activities...

RTC will reach out to UPCAP regarding Matter of Balance and ask about partnering with Regional Trauma on monitoring and evaluation of program.

Other transport mode


Inter-facility transfer

MCA PSROs could...

Work together with trauma programs to identify issues. Use reports to identify, track and trend.

Use the Advanced Search Dashboard to create a report for patients meeting trauma triage criteria by selecting those filters, your timeframe, emergency response type of service. Evaluate the tables and the records.

- □ Times.
- □ Destination choice.
- □ Provider impressions, care rendered.

Create reports for procedures, medications, National EMS Quality Alliance measures, etc.
